



Navy Intends to Issue Old Town Campus Revitalization Solicitation for Master Developer

As the Navy prepares to issue a competitive solicitation in late 2022 to identify a potential master developer for revitalization of the Naval Base Point Loma Old Town Campus (OTC), the Navy encourages developers and interested parties to [sign up for the project mailing list and text message alerts](#) (or update their contact information) to learn about doing business with the Navy and to receive the latest communications regarding the competitive development solicitation opportunity.

The Navy will work with the selected master developer on multiple options for potential private development of the site, while continuing to evaluate the feasibility of a NAVWAR-only development funded by traditional military construction methods.
