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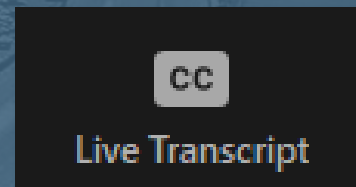

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NHPA Section 106 Process

Initiate the Process

- Determine undertaking and coordinate with NEPA review
- Notify State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO), federally recognized Tribes, and other consulting parties

Identify Historic Properties

- Determine Area of Potential Effect
- Identify historic properties
- Begin consultation with SHPO, federally recognized Tribes, and consulting parties

Assess Adverse Effects

- Apply criteria of adverse effect

Resolve Adverse Effects

WE ARE HERE

- Avoid, minimize, or mitigate adverse effects
- Notify Advisory Council on Historic Preservation
- Consult with SHPO, federally recognized Tribes, and consulting parties
- Involve the public

Agreement

- Memorandum of Agreement
- Process is complete with this stage



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Purpose of Today's Meeting

- Under the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA), the Navy determined the undertaking (revitalization of OTC) to be an adverse effect on historic properties.
- Historic properties include the Consolidated Aircraft Plant, 2 National Historic Landmarks (Casa de Estudillo and San Diego Presidio), and 17 additional properties.
- Today the Navy is soliciting ideas for how to resolve these adverse effects.
